DELIVERIES OR PERFORMANCE

- F.1 SOLICITATION PROVISIONS INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE (JUN 88)
(FAR 52.252-1) (FAR Text Reference 52.107(a)).

This solicitation incorporates one or more solicitation provisions by reference, with the same force and effect as if they were given in full text. Upon request, the Contracting Officer will make their full text available.

- F.3 NOTIFICATION OF SHIPMENT.

On the earliest possible date, the Contractor shall inform the recipient of each item of the date of shipment from the Contractor's facilities and the anticipated date of arrival at destination. This report shall be made no later than the actual date that the shipment is made from the Contractor's facilities. Point of contact at each Government destination will be provided at time of award of the delivery order.

- F.4 DELIVERY SCHEDULE.

(a) The Contractor shall deliver the ordered hardware and software items within 60 days after receipt of each delivery order placed for CONUS locations and within 90 days after receipt of each delivery order placed for OCONUS locations, except when the need of the Government permits, orders may provide a longer time of delivery.

(b) Upon issuance of a modification to any delivery order incorporating corrections to Blocks 18-23 of the DD Form 1155, Orders for Supplies or Services, or similar civilian agency orders, for the hardware/software CLINs only, the delivery schedule is automatically extended an additional 60 days, CONUS, and 90 days, OCONUS, after

receipt of the delivery order modification or as stated in the delivery order modification. The extension of the delivery schedule will affect the CLIN(s) needing correction if partial shipment was authorized, or for all the CLINs ordered if partial shipment is not authorized.

(c) The delivery schedule will be addressed on all delivery orders. For example, on the DD Form 1155, Orders for Supplies or Services, the deliver schedule will appear in Block 10. If the delivery schedule is stated elsewhere in the order, then Block 10 will indicate where the delivery schedule is located in the order. Paragraph F.5(a) describes the Technical Engineering Services delivery orders delivery schedule and modification procedures.

NOTE: Services will be ordered on a separate delivery order from hardware and software delivery orders.

F.5 PERFORMANCE SCHEDULE.

The Performance Schedule for technical engineering services, maintenance and training is as follows:

(a) Performance for Technical Engineering Services will be specified on each delivery order. Technical Engineering Services shall commence within 30 days after receipt of a delivery order or unless a later date is stated in the delivery order. The delivery schedule will be addressed on all delivery orders as to when the actual date the Technical Engineering Services will commence or be completed. For example, on the DD Form 1155, Orders for Supplies or Services, the deliver schedule will appear in Block 10. If the delivery schedule is stated elsewhere in the order, then Block 10 will indicate where the delivery schedule is located in the order. The initial delivery schedule stated on the Technical Engineering Service orders is an estimate delivery schedule. When the actual delivery schedule is known, then the contractor shall contact the issuing contracting officer for an extension of the delivery schedule stated on the order.

(b) Maintenance shall be specified on each delivery order and shall commence after the warranty has expired. Maintenance shall commence within 30 days after receipt of a delivery order or unless a later date is stated in the delivery order.

(c) The first training courses and conferences will be in accordance with the following list. Other training will be specified on each delivery order. However, the Government reserves the right to delay the training courses and conferences.

F.6 DELIVERY OF DATA.

Data shall be delivered in accordance with the schedules and to the destination specified on the Contract Data Requirement Lists (CDRL), DD 1423, Exhibit A.

F.7 PLACE OF DELIVERY/PERFORMANCE.

The place of delivery/performance shall be located worldwide. The specific location of the delivery/performance shall be specified on each delivery order.

F.8 INSTALLATION.

The Government agrees to have the site prepared in accordance with the Contractor's written site specifications 10 days prior to the scheduled installation date, unless a shorter period of time is agreed to, in writing, by the Contracting Officer at the appropriate ordering office.

F.9 PARTIAL SHIPMENTS.

Partial shipments are hereby authorized unless specifically prohibited by the issuing contracting officer and noted on each delivery order.
