

C. Part D-1 is changed as follows:

1. Add Paragraph 11.5.11 as follows:

11.5.11 Instructional Design and Development Specialist.

This specialist shall possess at least a Bachelor’s Degree from an accredited college or university in educational technology, instructional development, information technology/science or related discipline; or at least four years progressive experience in adult education design and development or instructional design. Additionally, the Instructional Design and Development Specialist shall possess extensive knowledge in adult learning styles and design of criterion-based learning. This specialist shall also be able to conduct effective training needs analysis and develop the interactions that successfully meet the objectives of the defined training. This

specialist will also have experience with current learning technologies and methodologies, particularly as it pertains to CBT delivery and interactive computing technologies, authoring systems, and hypertext utilities (web design and development). The specialist will possess demonstrated effective verbal and written communication skills, and interpersonal skills.

2. Add paragraph 11.5.12 as follows:

11.5.12 Technical Training Specialist.

This specialist shall possess at least a Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college or university, or at least four years experience in a field pertinent to this Contract. Additionally, the Technical Training Specialist shall have acquired a minimum of three years of progressive experience in training technical content to adult learners. This Specialist will possess excellent presentation skills, in-depth knowledge of subject matter, and strong knowledge of adult learning styles. Works with subject matter experts or industrial design and development specialist to prepare trainer's guides, handouts, job aids, and other support tools. Conducts needs analyses to assess training needs and measure training effectiveness; writes training programs. Coordinates training for courses delivered at customer sites. Assists in the ordering, inventory, and distribution of all course materials used in all training sessions. Possesses experience with web based or CD-ROM based computer learning systems. Maintains a working knowledge of industry standard software and hardware systems and relevant diagnostics.

3. Modify paragraph 4.14.1.8.1 as follows:

Identification plate dimensions shall be no less than 1.75 inches wide by 3.0 inches long. The thickness for all identification plates shall be 0.03 inch, plus or minus 0.0005 inch, without backing material.
