A. The purpose of this modification is:

1. To administratively correct the part numbers of SLIN X007BA in Part B-2. AP-4121-1151-US is changed to AP-4131-1050WW and ML-2499-APA1-00 is changed to ML-2499-APA2-01.

2. To incorporate CCP-0073 to add a software mobile and wireless application data access infrastructure runtime product, Odyssey Software, Inc.'s Cefusion for Windows CE and Pocket PC devices, and ViaXML for Windows CE, Pocket PC, Windows 95/98/ME and Windows NT/2000. Since no tangible product (e.g. CD or floppy diskette) will be delivered, the added SLINs are services and inspection and acceptance shall be in accordance with contract Part C-1-1(I).
